## WHAT IS AIS-140?

Automotive Industry Standard 140, commonly known as AIS 140, is a set of standards formulated and published by <u>the Automotive Research Association of India</u> (ARAI) as per the order issued by the <u>Automotive Industry Standards Committee</u> (AISC) of <u>the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.[1]</u> These standards are formulated to build and maintain an <u>intelligent transportation system</u> in <u>India</u>.

In January 2019, the Indian government directed all the state governments to enforce AIS 140-compliant GPS tracking devices with supporting software for all passenger-carrying buses and other public transport vehicles.

Unlike normal GPS Devices, VLTD (Vehicle Location Tracking Device) comes with an Esim which has 2 Profiles i.e. BSNL as primary and Airtel/Vodafone as Secondary. The device has capability to send data on 2 Server. 1st Server is of the state government (Common layer) and 2nd Server is of the GPS Provider.
